



A user clicks on a document link in the Web browser.



The Web browser sends a command for the requested document to WebLink.



Laserfiche sends the requested document to WebLink on demand. Because the documents are queried and sent to WebLink every time a user clicks on a link, any new changes to a document, such as annotations or appended pages, will be reflected immediately in the published repository.



WebLink requests the document from the Laserfiche repository.



WebLink translates Laserfiche documents into HTML.



WebLink sends the HTML to the browser and the document appears on the user's screen just moments after the he or she clicked the link. From the user's perspective, the link led directly to the document.
